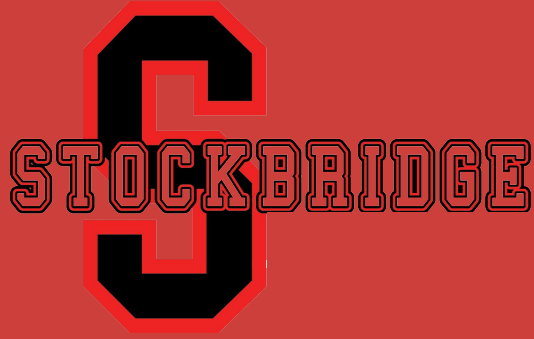

TEACHING AND LEARNING

- Our goal is to return to our Pre-COVID daily instructional routines and schedules as much as possible. More details will be provided in the Back to School packets later this summer.
- All students will have access to lockers PK-12.
- A virtual learning opportunity is available for all students if requested from Principal Meshak.
- HS students will have open campus lunch periods.
- All students will eat lunch in the cafeteria and lunch time will be grade specific.
- Water bottle fill stations are available in all three buildings.
- Students will be able to intermingle among different grades for academic/extra curricular related activities.
- On-site Mental Health Counseling Services available provided by Samaritan Counseling.

HEALTH AND SAFETY
