# Regular Board Meeting Minutes 

December 14, 2022-5:30 pm, Cafeteria

1. Call to Order at 5:32pm. Destiny, Tasha, Gina, Danielle and Julie were present. Katie, Annie and Jodi were not present.
2. Motion to Approve the Agenda made by Destiny, seconded by Tasha. All in favor.
3. Consent Items
a. Motion to approve November meeting minutes made by Gina, seconded by Destiny. All in favor.

a. Treasurer Report

10. Board Discussion:
i. Wreath Sale Results
a. Change To $11 / 17$ Noon pick up and one other day (possibly a $1 / 2$ day). Pick up the e wreaths the day before order pick up again. We should also get pricing from Honeymoon Acres to see what the price would be if they delivered the wreaths vs. SBC picking them up. Additionally, a suggestion to increase pot prices next year by $\$ 5-\$ 7$ for a better profit margin was made. Danielle reminded us we needed to be mindful and aware of the Hilbert Boy Scout's pris so that we're comparable.
ii. Basketball Update
a. SBC calendar will show 'SBC reservation' on Rschool calendar. Practices are on coaches to communicate through Team Reach.
b. School key fobs for coaches. It is school policy to provide key fobs to head coaches, not for assistant coaches.

d. Clock/Book Workers: This was previously a paid position paid to each individual per game. It has been hard to find workers to fill all needed positions. SBCAD requested that SBC members sign up for clock/book shifts. Discussion was had regarding these positions. Julie recommends to stop payment for book and clock

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workers, similar to softball. ( Parents are then assigned shifts to assist in needed positions.)
e. Gina recommended we lower admission fees in the future.
f. Discussed that if an SBC member takes a parent's shift, that is OK but if a parent misses a shift, a fee should be charged for having to fill that spot
g. Tasha recommends we inform parents at the parent meeting that no kids are allowed in the concession stand and set up parent meetings about concession/admission rules.
