Volleyball-survey results were positive overall. Nick Karls will be looking into the sink in the MS concession stand in the next month and giving the SBC a quote for repairs.

Soccer-end of season survey was positive overall. Fence/backstop was a total cost of 9,118 with the Booster club contributing 3, 795

Lake to Lake satellite team possibility-Gina has not had contact with anyone from the organization-but has sent messages for reply.

Softball-360U clinic dates will be sent to families for softball and baseball hitting/pitching clinics. The cost to families will be minimal as there is an anonymous community donor who will be contributing to the cost.

The three wheeler repairs and equipment needed (including a new rake on the three wheeler for dragging the field) totaled \$2, 494.05. A sign up for softball and baseball will go out in early January 2024 to determine potential teams.

The SBC is to host the 2024 Traveling League baseball tournament.
