Minutes

1. The Regular Meeting of the Stockbridge Board of Education was called to order by President Bill Parsons at 5:00 p.m. Joanne Propson, Bill Parsons, Dave Levknecht, Jennifer Funk, Julie Grebe, and Ann Holzer were present. Mr. Marx and Mr. Meshak were also in attendance. Guests present at the meeting included Dawn Grenzer, Dan Barker, Gavin Johnson, Joel Johnson, Paula Piper, Joe Kuhn, Ann Zitzelsberger and 8 other members of the community.
2. Mr. Marx noted this meeting was posted in three public places per Wisconsin Statute 19.84(1) and on-line.
3. Jennifer Funk moved and Dave Levknecht seconded to approve the Consent Items including the Agenda, Minutes of the 05/20/2021 Regular Meeting, vouchers totaling \$71,275.70 and the May Treasurer's Report with revenue of \$210,433.21 and expenditures of \$219,098.39. Motion carried on a 6 to 0 vote.
