Board of Education Regular Meeting April 25, 2024 Minutes

- 1. The Regular Meeting of the Stockbridge Board of Education was called to order by President Bill Parsons at 5:00pm. Bill Parsons, Jennifer Funk, Tracy Hanke, Rachel Parsons, Amanda Cullen and Ann Holzer were present. Mr. Marx and Mr. Meshak were also in attendance. Guests present included Emily Menzel, Lori Knoespel, Ashley Montour, and Jodi Hammen.
- 2. Mr. Marx noted this meeting was posted in three public places per Wisconsin Statute 19.84(1) and on-line.
