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General Guidelines:

The Stockbridge School District will once again offer summer school courses. Some classes may not operate due to small enrollment numbers. You will be notified if your course is **cancelled**. If you are not notified, please report the first day for class.

Registration:

Registration **begins on Thursday, April 10th, 2025 and ends on Friday, May 9th, 2025**. Handbook and registration forms will be posted on our school web page. Registration forms and payments can be submitted to the office from 8:00 am - 3:45 pm. Any student whose legal residence is within the boundaries of the Stockbridge School District may enroll in the Summer School Program. **Registration forms turned in after May 9th will not be accepted.**

Dates of Operation:

Summer school will operate Mondays - Thursdays beginning on Monday, **June 9th and run for three straight weeks through Thursday, June 26th**. Summer school classes run from 8:00-11:30, unless otherwise stated in the class description.

Library:

The library will be open for book check out on Wednesday's only from 8:00-12:00 in the months of June & July (except July 4th when applicable).

Supervision:

Summer School begins at 8:00 am, unless otherwise noted. Students may not arrive before that time. Students must be in a class at all times when attending Summer School. Students may not have any "gaps" in their schedules.

Cost:

There is no cost to students unless there is a materials fee or usage fee listed. Consult each course description for specific fees. **Fees are due at the time of registration** and they are non-refundable unless the class is cancelled. Payment can be either cash, check made to the Stockbridge Schools, or online through the optional payment menu in the parent portal.

Transportation:

Transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parent and student.

Attendance:

Daily attendance is encouraged for all classes. Please keep your teacher(s) informed of attendance situations.

Lunch:

No hot lunch service will be provided during summer school. Students are encouraged to bring a snack and drink for the day. **NO SODA OR ENERGY DRINKS WILL BE ALLOWED.**
